### PROSECCO SPUMANTE, COL BRIOSO DOC, VENETO, ITALY

Bright, straw yellow in colour with bags of fresh fruit aromas and flavours

### SPARKLING PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ, MIRABELLO, PAVIA, ITALY

A lively rosé fizz with delicate aromas of red berries and a palate of lush, summer fruits

## CHAMPAGNE

### LA CUVÉE BRUT LAURENT-PERRIER, NV, FRANCE

This Champagne has a delicate and fresh nose with good complexity and notes of citrus fruit

### ULTRA BRUT LAURENT-PERRIER, NV, FRANCE

This Champagne receives no 'dosage' prior to release. Its delicate finish, which leaves the palate fresh. Its subtle balance makes this wine an excellent choice for enhancing the flavours of a wide range of dishes and goes well with seafood

### VINTAGE, LAURENT-PERRIER BRUT, FRANCE

Only produced from the best vintages, this Champagne is bottle-aged for 7 years before release

### LA CUVÉE ROSÉ, LAURENT-PERRIER, NV, FRANCE

A fabulous rosé Champagne bursting with fresh, summer fruits with a dry finish and violet-floral hints

### GRAND SIÈCLE, LAURENT-PERRIER, LA GRAND CUVÉE, FRANCE

This luxury handcrafted cuvée has unique depth, finesse and complexity with a remarkable length of honeyed, nutty flavours of grilled almonds, hazelnuts and fresh pastry

### DOM PÉRIGNON, VINTAGE, FRANCE

The bouquet spirals through a light-filled floral softness to the gritty minerality that epitomises Dom Pérignon. Evocative of candied fruit, plant life and exquisite camphor leaf freshness, finally plunging into darkness, spices and liquorice root. This deluxe Champagne has rich, toasty aromas, wonderful apple, biscuit and lemon-rind flavours and a long, spicy, clean finish. Fabulous!

### NEW ZEALAND

#### PINOT NOIR, BOUNDARY HUT, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

This popular Pinot Noir is ruby red with a purple hue in colour with classic black cherry notes that dominate the palate and are supported by hints of bramble which is beautifully soft and well balanced

### ARGENTINA

#### MALBEC, GOYENECHA CENTENARIO, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

A deep red wine with some violet and purple highlights and a very good aromatic intensity with fruit notes of plums and blueberries and a distinctive smokey touch from the barrel

### CHILE

#### CARMENERE, TORREÓN DE PAREDES, RESERVA RENGÓ VALLEY, CHILE

Aromas of black ripe fruits, cherries, blackberries, cassis with black chocolate and vanilla notes from the oak ageing. The palate is round, supple and complex with firm tannins that ensure its potential for ageing gracefully in the bottle

### AUSTRALIA

#### SHIRAZ, CHOCOLATE BOX, BAROSSA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA

A bold Aussie Shiraz that really packs a punch. Scents of spice and cocoa are backed by a big splash of blackberry fruit. It also has sensual sandalwood, liquorice, toasted almond, praline and coffee. It's a big, juicy wine, full of roasted flavours and all wrapped up in smooth vanilla

#### SHIRAZ, NORMANS HOLBROOK ROAD, AUSTRALIA

A fleshy rich, fruit driven wine with dominate fruit flavours of black cherry and dark plums, coupled with peppery spice showing typical South Australian Shiraz characters

### AMERICA

#### PINOT NOIR, PARDUCCI SMALL LOT BLEND MENDOCINO, USA

Displays good Pinot Noir characteristics with aromas of raspberries and strawberries. The palate shows hints of cedar and vanilla with fine, luscious tannins that linger on the finish

#### PINOT NOIR, BROTHERHOOD WINERY, WASHINGTONVILLE, NEW YORK STATE, USA

The famous dessert wine from Bergerac, is rich and complex and has mouth-watering honey, sweet spice and orange blossom flavours

## RED WINE

### FRANCE

#### **BORDEAUX, CHÂTEAU BRANDE-BERGÈRE, FRANCE**

Brande-Bergère is officially ranked the Number One producer of Bordeaux Supérieur out of the 900 producers in that region

#### **BEAUJOLIAS, CHÂTEAU DES LABOURONS, FLEURIE, FRANCE**

The 'Queen of Beaujolais' this wine has a nice ruby red colour with purple lights, intense flavours of blackberry and blackcurrant with a supple and silky finish with beautiful violet and slightly peppery notes

#### **CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE, RÈSERVE DES ARGENTIER, RHONE, FRANCE**

A firm favourite with red wine drinkers, this wine has a complex bouquet with fruits and spices, thyme, rosemary and pepper and a long rewarding and silky finish

#### **POMEROL, L'ENCHANTEUR DE VRAY DE GAY, FRANCE**

A polished, friendly style with flattering plum and boysenberry fruit framed by toasted vanilla, cherry eau-de-vie and red liquorice notes that glide through the finish

### SPAIN

#### **RIOJA, VIÑA AMATE CRIANZA, SPAIN**

This Crianza was aged in American oak barrels for 12 months with a further 12 in the bottle, creating a soft and smooth Rioja with hints of vanilla and chocolate on the nose

#### **RIOJA, BERONIA RESERVA, SPAIN**

Deep ruby-maroon in colour with plenty of density and a complex nose, dominated by cinnamon and clove notes with hints of toasted bread and a velvety texture. Plenty of warm fruit, sweet tannins

### ITALY

#### **CORVINA, CASTELFORTE VERONA, ITALY**

A dry, full-bodied red from the Veneto region that has a intense ruby red colour with a deep scent of black cherries and ripe blackberry. With hints of vanilla and sweet spices

#### **MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO, CERULLI SPINOZZI, ITALY**

An intense and complex red from Italy with notes of rich ripe cherries, blackberries, blackcurrants and cloves

#### **PRIMITIVO, SCHOLA SARMENTI CRITERA SALENTO, ITALY**

Very sweet-fruited on the palate, this is a big, rich and warming wine, with gentle ripe tannins and enough acidity to balance it

#### **AMARONE, CASTELFORTE, VENETO, ITALY**

A wine with vibrant cherry and chocolate on nose with a creamy, plummy palate and a long finish. This wine is made for big flavoured food

#### **BAROLO, PIEMONTE, PATRIZI, ITALY**

This 'King of Wines' from Piedmonte with a deep garnet red colour with orange reflections and a dry, full, strong, austere and harmonious taste

### SOUTH AFRICA

#### **SAUVIGNON BLANC, STILL BAY, SOUTH AFRICA**

Crafted in the classic Sauvignon style, intense but elegant, it's an extremely enjoyable wine with instant appeal

#### **VIOGNIER, SARONSBERG, TULBAGH, SOUTH AFRICA**

This delightful Viognier from the Western Cape has a light straw colour and flavours of honey, pear, apricot and delicate floral notes. It has a rich, silky palate with subtle spice and yellow fruit flavours, light oak and a balanced fresh finish

### FRANCE

#### **VIOGNIER, LE VERSANT, PAYS D'OC, FRANCE**

A luscious mouthful of ripe white peaches and a hint of sweet spice, this is like bottled Languedoc sunshine and if you have never tried Viognier before you should try this!

#### **PICPOUL DE PINET, LE JEANTELS, FRANCE**

An ultra-trendy grape varietal which has been grown in the South of France for over 400 years. Offering something a little different, it is light and delicate in style with a hint of peaches and apricots on the finish

#### **CHARDONNAY JEAN MACON VILLAGES "LA CROCHETTE"**

Well structured wine with great balance, rich buttery flavours from subtle oak aging. This burgundy punches well above its weight

This amazing Sancerre has an lively bouquet, redolent of broom with citrus notes on the palate for overall harmony and a pale gold colour.

Steely, fresh and bright with green apple and citrus flavours and a good minerality this Chablis is clean & flavoursome

## WHITE WINE

### SPAIN

#### LIGHTLY SPARKING MACBEO-XARELLO-PARELLADA, PESCADOR, SPAIN

Pescador is made using natural fermentation and is fine, light and has a natural sparkle. In Spanish these wines are called 'Vinos de Aguja' which means 'needle-wines' so don't expect the full-on fizz of a Cava but something far more subtle, but just as satisfying!

#### RIOJA BLANCO, BERONIA VIURA, SPAIN

An intense and fresh white Rioja with fruit aromas such as apple and mango standing out over a base of citrus which gives freshness, with a balanced, long and persistent finish

#### ALBARIÑO, RIAS BAIXAS, NAMORIO, SPAIN

A zippy and racy Albariño with delicate floral aromas on the nose and hints of peach on the palate. An incredibly light and refreshing style of white wine

### ITALY

#### ORGANIC PINOT GRIGIO, TERRAMORE, VENETO, ITALY

With a strong yellow straw colour and an unmistakable and immediate bouquet this lovely wine has an intense impression of acacia flowers and a palate that is dry, full-bodied, well balanced

#### ORGANIC FIANO, SCHOLA SARMENTI, APULIA, ITALY

This organic white from the 'heel' of the Italian peninsula has a nose of lime and lemon notes with a smokey edge. The palate is both powerful and crisp with citrus fruits and hints of almond. Bone dry and with a long finish

#### GAVI DI GAVI, CASTELLARI BERGAGLIO, PIEDMONT, ITALY

With appealing fragrances of pear and green apple this wine has impressive volume and weight in the mouth with superb balance of all components

### NEW ZEALAND

#### SAUVIGNON BLANC, BOUNDARY HUT, OHAU, NEW ZEALAND

This Boundary Hut is produced in Ohau, arguably New Zealand's most exciting new sub region. This classic New Zealand Sauvignon-Blanc is bursting with vibrant, citrus and tropical notes and is fantastic for drinking alone or paired with white fish

#### SAUVIGNON BLANC, FIRST DAWN, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

A classic Kiwi Sauvignon-Blanc, packed with vibrant citrus and grassy flavours along with refreshing acidity and a crisp, dry finish

### ARGENTINA

#### CHARDONNAY, GOYENECHEA, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

As this is an un-oaked Chardonnay, the fruit really shines through giving this wine a fresh bouquet against a backdrop of creamy aromas and a scent of mango

#### ZINFANDEL ROSÉ, WILLOWOOD, CALIFORNIA, USA

A lively, fruity rosé wine with aromas of red summer fruits and an attractive, crisp sweetness on the palate

#### MERLOT, STILL BAY, SOUTH AFRICA

A medium-bodied Merlot from the Western Cape with dark, spicy rich fruits on the palate, juicy tannins and a hint of oak on a lingering finish
